Common Sources of Hazards

- Walking and working surfaces
- Machines/equipment
- Electrical
- Chemical
- Environmental
- Ergonomic/material handling
- Unsafe work practices

Leading Factors that Cause Accidents

Unsafe act - Performed any time an employee fails to abide by safety rules and protocols. Includes performing the job without the necessary safety equipment.

Unsafe condition - Any condition that could cause an undue hazard to the life, limb, or health of any person authorized or expected to be on or about the premises.
